Important safety communication to help us Work SAFER! SEPT. 2, 2020

Note new safety information for LCE (Americas elevator controller) / KONE Drive Modulator fast start parameter setting Work SAFER! – Stored energy

IMPORTANT

Distribution: U.S. / Canada KONE technicians; general managers, service managers and service supervisors

Issue:

When the fast start sequence parameter 7-90 is set to "1" on systems with KDM drives, it may affect the control system including the curtain of light, the hoistway door lock, and the elevator car door lock status.

Cause:

The parameter value for the fast start sequence on the elevators equipped with KDM drive modules shipped from the factory between Sept. 21, 2015 and March 3, 2020 had a default setting of "1." If the setting is not adjusted to "0," then the elevator may move in an unexpected manner.

Required corrective actions:

This safety alert is an interim measure to advise technicians of the issue and request that they take necessary action, as appropriate.

- 1. Technicians performing scheduled maintenance at locations with KDM drive modules installed shall inspect the parameter setting and if it is set to "1" they should switch the parameter to "0".
- 2. A retrofit will be issued in the near future that will cover all affected units. This retrofit will provide more detailed instructions for changing the parameter and a warning label to advise of the issue
